Granted by the European Society for Biomaterials (ESB), the Jean Leray Award is one of the most prestigious awards in the field

Researcher from 3B's Research Group wins Jean Leray Award



Miguel Oliveira, principal investigator from the Biomaterials, Biodegradables and Biomimetics Research Group (3B's) of the EEUM, a member of the associate laboratory ICVS/3B's of the UMinho, was granted the Jean Leray Award 2015. In the last 15 years, Miguel Oliveira has been developing natural origin biomaterials for application in several approaches on tissue engineering and regenerative medicine, namely for treatment of musculoskeletal disorders. He has also worked with nanotechnology and stem cells applied to developing disease models (e.g.: osteoarthritis and cancer). The Jean Leray Award, granted by the European Society for Biomaterials (ESB), is one of the most prestigious awards in the field. The award is destined to recognize, encourage and stimulate outstanding research contributions to the field of biomaterials by young scientists up to 40 years old who have concluded their PhD in the last 8 years.
